

Behind the Scenes

ver 200 volunteers work year round with WFOL staff to develop programming, prepare for events, create lighting designs, secure partnerships and raise funds through donations, government grants and corporate sponsorships. Our team is dedicated to bringing a world class festival to Niagara Falls in the winter season.

The Festival has worked hard to strengthen the relationship with our founding partner The Niagara Parks Commission (NPC) year after year. Each season NPC staff are hard at work installing displays along the Niagara Parkway following Labour Day, NPC staff log over 5,000 hours on installations and preparations for Opening Ceremonies. During the Festival's offseason, NPC's trade specialists work with WFOL Staff to refurbish old displays and create new ideas.

Shear Display has been installing and creating custom illuminations for the Festival for over 30 years. With 2,000,000 LED lights used, 25,000 feet of extension cord, 3,000 man hours and nearly 65,000 lbs of temporary infrastructure deployed in Dufferin Islands alone! This team works through rain, snow and sleet each year to make it happen. More than just a supplier. Shear Display is a member of our team, continuously sponsoring the Festival and provide consultation throughout the planning stages which begin early March.

There are many partners within the community that work very hard to make the Festival of Lights what it is today, Thank you to the Business Improvement Groups for their constant support with moving forward in lighting up the city as well as continuous excitement pertaining to programing.

Volunteers: Make it Happen






